WHAT IS APEL?

APEL stands for ACCREDITATION OF PRIOR EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING. It is defined as a systematic process that involves the identification, documentation and assessment of prior experiential learning.

In general, APEL process involves the assessment of experiential learning. This learning may be acquired through various channels which include formal schooling, work and life experiences, training, independent study, voluntary work, hobbies and others.

WHY APEL?

APEL is created to provide an 'alternative' entry method to those with no formal qualification to further their education to a higher level. It encourages an individual to continuously enhance their knowledge which can lead to a respective certification of qualification. This will provide opportunity to the individuals to obtain better jobs.

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The APEL assessments are for admission to UNIRAZAK Master and Degree programme only.

WHO CAN APPLY APEL?

1. Malaysian Citizen
2. Minimum age
 - Admission to UNIRAZAK Degree Programme : 21 years old
 - Admission to UNIRAZAK Master Programme: 30 years old and have STPM / Diploma / A-Level / equivalent

(Candidates who possess unrecognised diploma from MQA must complete 2 years of study with 90 credit hours).

3. Relevant work experience
4. Passes APEL assessment

APEL ASSESSMENT

1. Aptitude Test

4 aspects will be tested:

- Bahasa Melayu
- English
- Mathematics
- General Knowledge / Critical Thinking

2. Portfolio

- Compilation of experience
- Based on a format

3. Interview

- For Master's candidate only
- 15 to 45 minute
